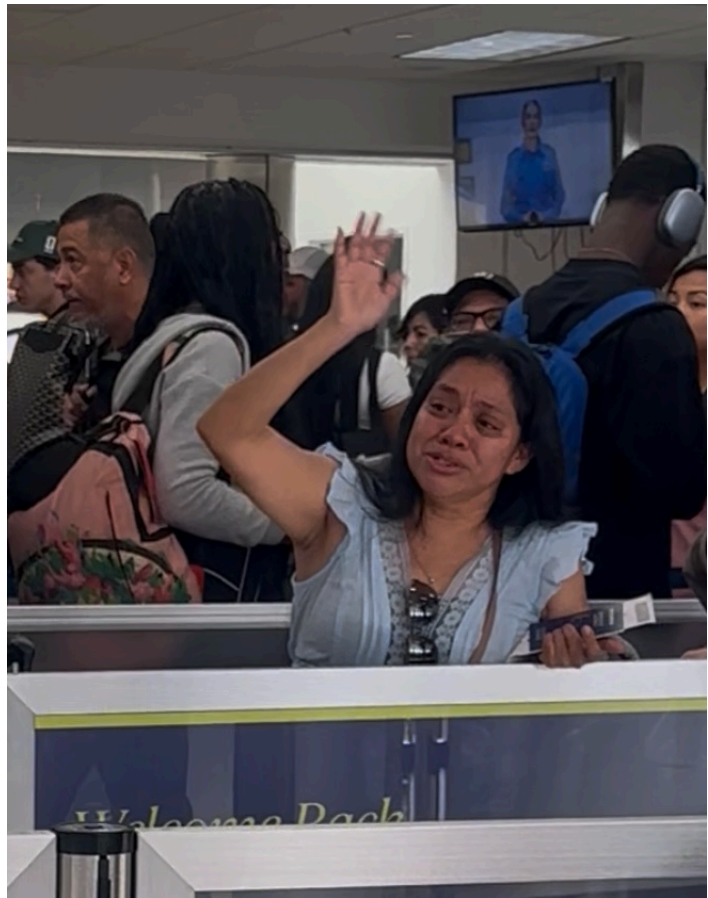


Olga Says Goodbye to Her Children and Home of 30 Years
